

Have you ever walked through an art show and thought, “my work is better than this – I should be in this show” Well, if you are a young artist between the ages of 15 – 25, living in the Rochester New York vicinity, and have never participated in a juried art festival,

THIS IS YOUR CHANCE!

In an effort to cultivate and assist our local young artists, the Corn Hill Arts Festival is offering the opportunity to experience showing and selling artwork at our festival in an easy and low-cost manner.

The artist will go through the application and jury process. Each applicant will be juried with similar young artists’ works by a panel of art professionals. Those selected to participate will be provided space in a tent within the Corn Hill Festival site.

Corn Hill Arts Festival will provide the following to accepted artists:

- 10 x 10 foot space under a tent
- Central payment site*
- Promotional materials
- Media PR

*All sales transactions will be handled through a central cashier provided by the festival. Cash, check or credit card payments will be accepted. CHNA will collect a 10% fee to cover sales tax and processing. Participants will not need to have their own tax ID number to sell.

Artists must provide:

- Their own original artwork represented by their application images
- Displays (tables, easels, etc).
- Transportation of artwork to and from the festival

Awards: All participants artwork will be reviewed by the judges and a first and second place prize will be awarded.

Application process: (Submit a CD-ROM with the following)

- 1) Your completed application
- 2) Three images of your work in jpeg format
- 3) Short description of your work

Fees: \$10 application fee (non-refundable). Please submit this payment with your application CD. If accepted, you will be required to submit \$20 space fee by June 8th, 2012.

RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

1. All items displayed and sold must be designed and executed by the accepted artist. If the items on display are deemed not to be original artwork (e.g. “buy and sell”), the Festival management committee reserves the right to remove the artist from the show. No refunds will be given in this situation. Items displayed for sale must be consistent with the accepted juried images. In the event the artist does not meet these rules and is asked to leave, CHAF is not liable for lost profits or travel expenses.
2. Exhibitors may not advertise discounted, reduced or “sale” prices.
3. In response to requests from residents, Exhibitors are not permitted to sell real or toy replicas or representations of guns, knives or similar items, which may resemble weapons.

Corn Hill Arts Festival Timeline:

Application Deadline: **April 20, 2012** \$10 fee must be submitted with the application.

Notification: **May 21, 2012**

Final payment due: **June 8, 2012**

Booth set-up only: **July 6 after noon. (no art work left overnight on Friday)**

Display set-up: **July 7 by 8:30 am (All vehicles must be removed by 8:30 AM)**

Festival times: **July 7 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.; July 8 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. (No early departures are allowed.)**
